


The role of gas in the European energy mix

- Gas accounts for 24% of EU energy mix, and 23% of electricity generation.
- High level of external dependence.
- Annual EU consumption 500 bcm.
- Total Gas imports 370 bcm.
- Southern Eastern Europe remains vulnerable and highly dependent on their traditional import routes





Europe's natural gas consumption is projected to grow while its own domestic natural gas production continues to decline. If trends continue as projected and no measures are taken, Europe will have to face difficult situations.

Natural gas reserves, linking up supply

Russia holds the largest natural gas reserves in the world, and is the largest producer and exporter of dry natural gas.




The South Stream gas pipeline will ensure a direct connection between hydrocarbons suppliers and consumers



Project information:

- Number of gas pipeline strings: 4
- 63 bcm of natural gas per year
- Over 900 km under the surface of the Black Sea
- Design life: Minimum 50 years
- Maximum depth: 2,250 meters
- Length of each pipe segment: 12 meters



It aims to provide the EU with a secure, reliable and sustainable energy supply at a competitive price


South Stream Gas Pipeline Project II

The South Stream Pipeline will provide benefits for the countries involved in this project:

- Sustainable, diversified gas supplies.
- Create new industrial infrastructure.

- Raise the level of energy safety.
